

DRAMA AND THEATRE ARTS LEVEL 8

There are no National Curriculum levels for Drama. The following statements are used in order to give an indication of the level of attainment achieved to date.

Pupils working at Level 8 are able to:

- ◆ explore the dramatic potential of a wide range of stimuli
- ◆ rehearse and perform both improvised and scripted drama with good control of the skills of actor or director
- ◆ work effectively as part of a group to produce work which is controlled and mature
- ◆ show their work has impact and fully engages the audience
- ◆ comment on strengths and weaknesses of performances and give clear ideas on how they might be improved, showing an excellent knowledge of theatre conventions and devices

A pupil working at this level is far exceeding the expected attainment level for the whole year group.
