### Year 7 Progress Report

I am writing to make you aware that your child's Year 7 Progress Report is now available on eportal under the 'Reports' tab within your child's profile.

As this is the first progress report for your child at Swanmore College we have included details of their attitude to learning in each of their subjects. This is shown as an overall grade for Attitude to Learning (Aut AtL) which refers to pupil focus and commitment to learning as defined below:

<b>Excellent</b>	Exceptionally focussed, independent and conscientious
<b>Good</b>	Usually focussed and conscientious
<b>Satisfactory</b>	Only just adequate focus and commitment to work
<b>Unsatisfactory</b>	Lacks focus and commitment to work
<b>X</b>	Pupil was absent too often for reasonable assessment to be made

If there is a homework concern (Aut Hwk) or personal organisation concern (Aut PO) this will also be stated. Over the next week tutors will be discussing your child's report with them and setting generic targets.


