

## **GEOGRAPHY KEY STAGE 3 LEVEL 7**

Pupils at Key Stage 3 Level 7 perform well in a number of the following aspects which show that they are able to:

- ◆ show knowledge, skills and understanding of a wide range of places.
- ◆ describe interactions between physical and human processes and show how these interactions cause changes in places.
- ◆ understand that people's attitudes and values influence their decisions about places.
- ◆ understand that actions in one place can have effects on people's lives and environments in another place.
- ◆ recognise that human actions may have unintended environmental consequences.
- ◆ understand that geographical change can sometimes lead to conflict.
- ◆ appreciate how sustainable development can affect the planning and management of environments and resources.

In geographical enquiry, they are able to:

- ◆ identify geographical questions and issues independently.
- ◆ select and use accurately a wide range of skills to gather data.
- ◆ present well-argued summaries of their investigations.
- ◆ reach substantiated conclusions and critically evaluate their sources of evidence.
