

Within your child's progress report you will find the Year 11 target (Key Stage 4 target) .We have also given an indication of their current grade bearing in mind pupils have only completed 5 months of a 20 month course. We have also given overall grades for Attitude to Learning which refers to pupil focus and commitment to learning as defined below:

<b>Excellent</b>	Exceptionally focussed, independent and conscientious
<b>Good</b>	Usually focussed and conscientious
<b>Satisfactory</b>	Only just adequate focus and commitment to work
<b>Unsatisfactory</b>	Lacks focus and commitment to work
<b>X</b>	Pupil was absent too often for reasonable assessment to be made

If there is an Independent Learning concern (Spr Ind) with homework or coursework or a Personal Organisation concern (Spr PO) this will be stated. The pupils have been advised of their targets and are receiving guidance on how to reach these.
