The Geography Department at Swanmore College is part of Attenborough House that includes Geography, History, R.E, Citizenship, PE and Music. At present, there are four specialist Geography teachers.

At Key Stage 3, the department follows a well developed scheme of work based on the key concepts of place, space, scale, interdependence, environmental issues, processes and diversity as the National Curriculum for geography suggests. Geographical enquiry and key skills of mapping and graphicacy are very important.

At Key Stage 4, the department follows the OCR syllabus. The Geography GCSE results are usually 80+ A* - C, making the department one of highest achievers in the county over the last five years.
