The Humanities Faculty is housed in S block with each room being equipped with data projector technology. The faculty has a broad and well-balanced range of resources. The team consists of nine full time teachers and one part time specialist teacher.

At Key Stage Three, History, Geography and RE follow an exciting and innovative curriculum. Results at Key Stage Three, in all three areas are well above the national average. Citizenship is also taught within the department in discreet fortnightly lessons.

Classes at Key Stage Three are taught in sets based on ability, and teachers are asked to teach across the age and ability range. All teachers in the Humanities Department teach their specialist subject plus Citizenship and RE.

At Key Stage Four, the faculty achieves some of the best results in the county both for RE, History and Geography. All pupils will follow a course of core RE, Citizenship and Personalised Learning from September.
