Information – The Home Access Scheme

Home Access is the government programme which will help ensure that more children in state-maintained education in England have access to technology at home to support learning.

The programme begins its full rollout across England this month and initially will target learners in Years 3 to 9 inclusive.

Low-income families who meet set eligibility criteria can apply to a central body for a Home Access Grant to purchase a compliant computer and internet package from a range of approved suppliers.
