### Use of Bicycles

We support the environmentally friendly use of bicycles by pupils. In order to ensure the safety of pupils who wish to cycle to college we request that the following procedures to be adhered to.

We expect ALL pupils who ride a bicycle to be equipped with and wear cycle helmets.

Pupils wishing to travel to college by bicycle should first obtain a permit from the college. Forms for completion by parents are available from the college office.

Bicycles must be dismounted at the main gate. They must be left in the place provided. The bicycle shed is out of bounds during the day.

It is important that bicycles are maintained in a road-worthy condition, post coded and securely locked during college hours.

### Cars

Parents who bring their children to college by car may for reasons of safety only deposit them by either the lower pedestrian gate or the top double gate, again for reasons of safety. Parents may not park on the zigzag yellow lines or reverse their cars in any of the college entrances.

### College Mini Buses

These are operated and maintained against the strict regulations framework established by Government.

Only fully mini bus driver trained and qualified staff are allowed to drive the mini buses and journeys in excess of a 30 mile radius of the college are undertaken by professional transport providers.
